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Vote by Mail Request Period Ending for the March 17, 2015 Senate District 21 Special Primary Election

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds L.A. County voters to request a Vote by Mail ballot by Tuesday, March 10 for the Senate District 21 Special Primary Election, which takes place on March 17th.

To date, the RR/CC has mailed more than 116,700 Vote by Mail ballots to voters who live in the cities of Lancaster, Palmdale, and parts of Santa Clarita.

Please note, beginning January 1, 2015 all Vote by Mail ballots postmarked by Election Day will be counted if received within three days by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk ([California Senate Bill 29](#)).
