Polls Closed and First Ballot Count for the Senate District 32 Special General Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the closing of the polls for today's Senate District 32 Special General Election.

The first Election Night ballot count includes **29,701** returned Vote by Mail ballots out of **201,632** Vote by Mail ballots issued in the district.

Updates to the tally will be made throughout the evening as ballots arrive from all **408** polling places to Norwalk Headquarters for central tabulation.
