Ballots Left to be Counted for the March 3, 2015 Consolidated Elections

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reported an initial estimate of outstanding ballots to be processed during the canvass period for the March 3, 2015 Consolidated Elections (Cities of Bell, Cudahy and Huntington Park). The initial estimate includes outstanding provisional and Vote by Mail ballots collected at the polls, as well as Vote by Mail ballots received in the mail by 8 p.m. on Election Day.
