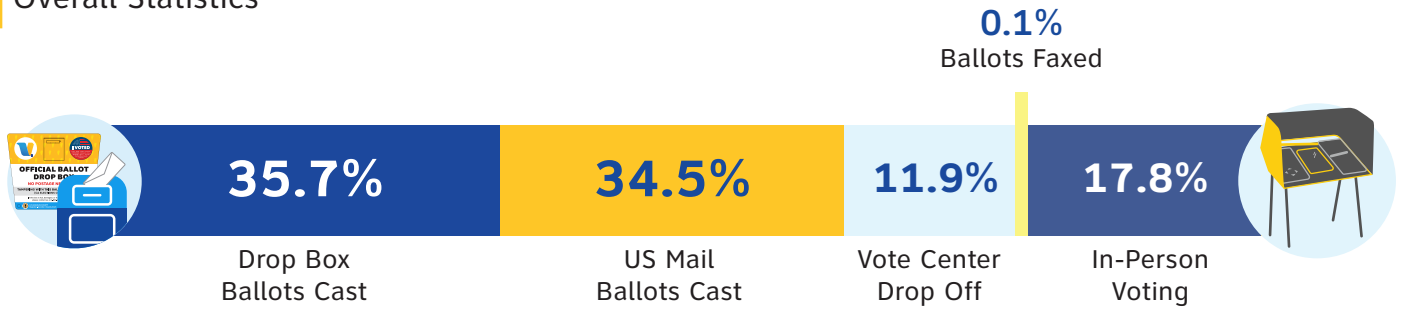

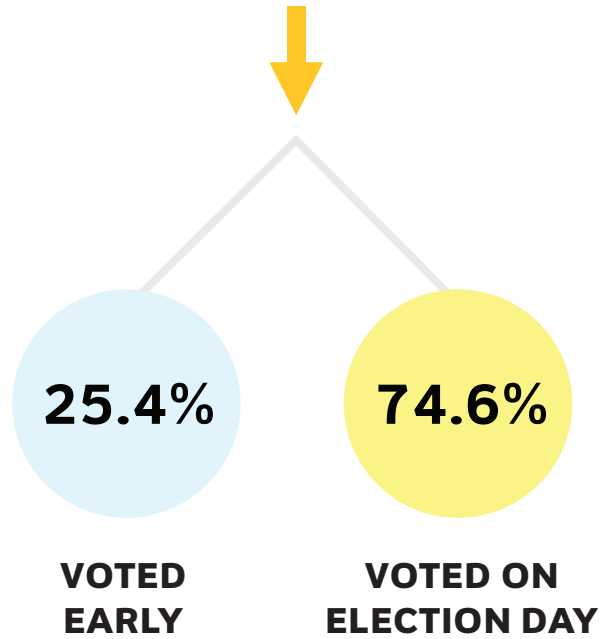


OVER 3.4 MILLION

PERCENTAGE OF BALLOTS NOT COUNTED*

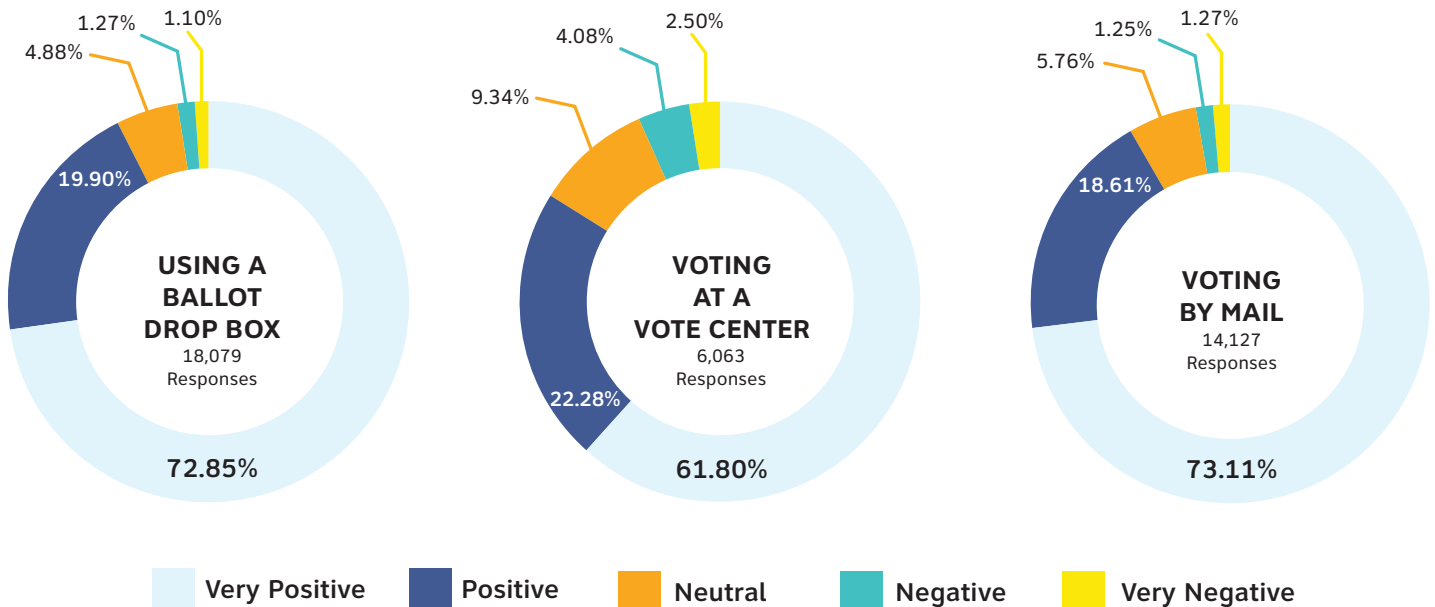
