305,746 Sample Ballot Booklets Mailed for the Congressional District 34 Special Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) began mailing 305,746 sample ballot booklets to voters for the 34th Congressional District Special Primary Election.

This election is to fill the vacancy in the 34th Congressional District when Xavier Becerra took the position of California Attorney General.

Sample ballot booklets contain important election information, including candidates that will appear on the ballot. The back cover of the booklet indicates a voter's polling place location and also serves as a Vote by Mail request application.

To receive a sample ballot booklet, individuals must be registered to vote. To register to vote or to check voter registration status, L.A. County residents can visit lavote.net.
