May 14, 2013 Senate District 32 Special General Election Semi-Final Official Results Reported

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC), Dean Logan, announced Semi-Final Official Results for the May 14, 2013 Senate District 32 Special General Election, with 8.97% of eligible registered Pomona voters casting ballots. A total of 5,215 ballots were processed and counted on Election Night.

The Official Election Canvass period begins on Wednesday, May 15 and ends on Friday, May 24. During the Official Canvass, all outstanding provisional and Vote by Mail ballots will be verified and tallied. The RR/CC will also conduct a 1% Manual Audit. During this period, the RR/CC is scheduled to release the Final Official Results.

On Wednesday, May 29, the RR/CC is tentatively scheduled to certify the results to the California Secretary of State.
